# Real estate agent raising cancer research funds

Comox real estate agent Dave Procter is doing something special to celebrate his 50th birthday this year, and you can help him.

Procter says he will cycle this summer from Victoria to Halifax to raise money for the B.C. Cancer Foundation for breast cancer research.

"I have been blessed that neither my family nor I have been affected by cancer, but I have witnessed a number of friends and clients deal with the challenges of this unforgiving disease," he comments on his personal cancer fundraising website. "Now, I want to give back to the community and to the company that has been so good to me," he adds. Procter estimates the trip, on which he will be accompanied by his children as well as life partner and fellow Re/Max agent Leah Reichelt, will last nine or 10 weeks.

Reichelt, Procter notes on his real estate website, "is also a supporter of breast

cancer research having participated in the Weekend to End Breast Cancer, a 60-km walk through the streets of Vancouver."

Procter says he hopes to visit Re/Max offices on his route across Canada, and encourages salespeople to ride for the day with him as he travels through their communities.

"My goal while I ride across the country is to raise as much money as I can for breast cancer research at the BC Cancer Agency and to do my best to visit a number of Re/Max offices on my journey," Procter states.

issued for amounts of \$20 or more.
